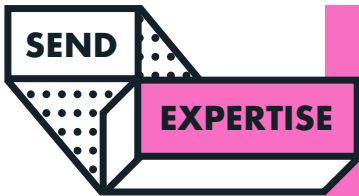

At one special school, Pop Up Festival helped **triple** the percentage of pupils who made progress above expectation in writing from **29% to 91%** over three years. The same school increased from **zero to 85** pupils achieving English GCSE, as a direct result of taking part.

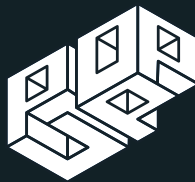
